- 3) Scouts - deliver empty bags to your selected neighborhood between Sat Feb 13 and Thurs Feb 18
- 4) Scouts - pick up full bags from the houses on **SATURDAY FEB 20**
- 5) Scouts - deliver the bags to the nearest Goodwill store or collection site (locations provided in information packet)
