Upon successful completion of the Leave No Trace Trainer Course, each participant will become a qualified Leave No Trace Trainer. Those who complete the course are equipped to:

- Understand, demonstrate, and teach minimum impact techniques;
- Lead outdoor ethics discussions and help others explore their own personal outdoor ethic; and,
- Conduct Leave No Trace Awareness Workshops and may assist at Leave No Trace Trainer courses.

Schedule: Check-in will begin at 8:00 AM on Saturday. Course starts at 9:00 AM and will run through Sunday, 4 PM. Session involves overnight camping. The course will be taught by a Leave No Trace Master Educator(s) and Leave No Trace Trainer(s).

Course Description: Participants will receive hands-on training in Leave No Trace skills, ethics, and the seven principles. Other related topics may be discussed.

What to bring: Copy of current Medical Form (returned upon completion on Sunday), paper and pen. Camping basics: Tent, sleeping bag, and ground pad or cot, a plate and utensils, water bottle, sunscreen, hat, closed-toe shoes, and flashlight. Clothing appropriate for weather conditions. Your personal needs, such as medication. Any props for your 12-15 minute presentation.

What will be provided: Saturday lunch & dinner, Sunday breakfast & lunch, and snacks will be provided. There will be no cracker-barrel. Training course material will also be provided.

Recognition: Upon completion of the course, New Leave No Trace Trainer position of responsibility patch will be presented to youths (see patch above); Leave No Trace Trainer strip will be presented to leaders; a certificate of recognition as a Leave No Trace Trainer by the Leave No Trace Center for Outdoor Ethics will be sent; a course certificate and BSA Leave No Trace Trainer card.

Fee: Registration is \$60 paid to Catalina Boy Scout Council by the registration deadline. An additional \$15 shall be added to non-Boy Scout participant registrant for their BSA registration. Course is limited to 25 participants. Minimum number of eight participants is required in order for the course to be conducted. Please sign up early to insure your reservation. Minimum age is 14 years old with parental permission, if a participant is under 18 years old.
